Note: When using \$true or \$false in PowerShell, you can think of \$true as meaning "on" and \$false as meaning "off."

Who can present

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"
-DesignatedPresenterRoleMode EveryoneUserOverride
```

Microsoft Team Admin Center option	PowerShell
Only organizers and co-organizers	OrganizerOnlyUserOverride
People in my org and guests	EveryoneInCompanyUserOverride
Everyone	EveryoneUserOverride

Screen sharing

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"
-ScreenSharingMode SingleApplication
```

Microsoft Team Admin Center option	PowerShell
Entire screen	EntireScreen
Single application	SingleApplication
Disabled	Not enabled

Participants can give or request control

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"
-AllowParticipantGiveRequestControl $true
```

External participants can give or request control

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-AllowExternalParticipantGiveRequestControl $false
```

PowerPoint Live

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-AllowPowerPointSharing $true
```

Whiteboard

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-AllowWhiteboard $true
```

Collaborative annotations

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-AllowAnnotations $true
```

Live share

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-AllowDocumentCollaboration Enabled
```

Microsoft Team Admin Center option	PowerShell
Off	Disabled
On	Enabled

Shared notes

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-AllowSharedNotes $true
```

Organizer can restrict participants from copying or forwarding meeting chat messages

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-CopyRestriction $true
```

Participants can share content in external meetings hosted by

```
PS C:\Users\UserName> Set-CsTeamsMeetingPolicy -Identity "MyCustomPolicy"  
-ContentSharingInExternalMeetings EnabledForAnyone
```

Any org	EnabledForAnyone
Trusted orgs and guests	EnabledForTrustedOrgs
No other orgs	Disabled
