

What is SUID ?

- SUID or Set Owner User ID is a permission bit flag that applies to executables.
- SUID allows an alternate user to run an executable with the same permissions as the owner of the file instead of the permissions of the alternate user.

```

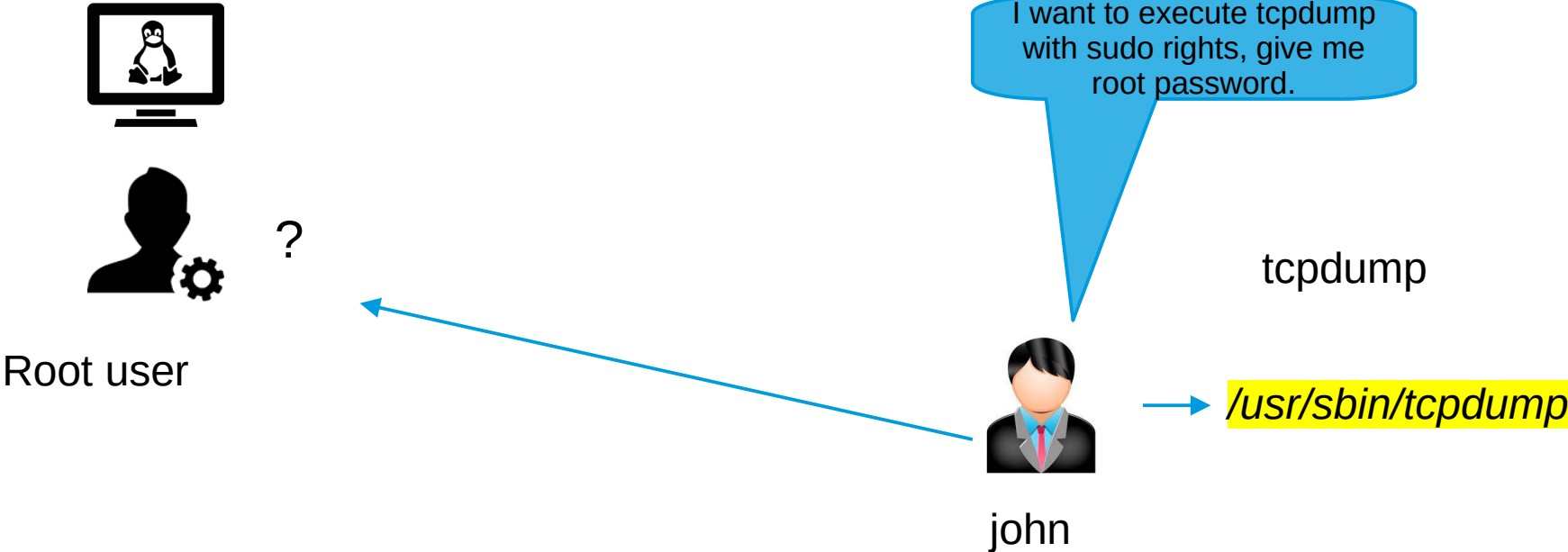
How to find SUID files ?
