

Using LaunchDaemons to Erase User Folders After Reboot

Updates / Corrections

The script used will delete the actual account and not just the home folder, so, this script is really only useful for network accounts.

For example, if you create a local account called student, and this script erases it, then the student account will be deleted. After the computer reboots, you won't be able to login as student. If 'student' were a network account, then, 'student' would be able to login again as that account is stored on a directory server (Active Directory) and not just the computer.
