



Containers vs VMs

#### Containers vs Virtual Machines

- ➤ Containers and virtual machines both have similar resource allocation and allocation benefits.
- ➤ Containers and VMs are functionally different because containers virtualise the Operating System and VMs are virtualise the hardware.
- Containers are more portable.

### Containers vs Virtual Machines



#### Containers are not VMs

- ➤ Containers are just processes.
- ➤ Containers are limited what resources they can access.
- ➤ Exit when process exits.
