- Web Tracking is the practice by which websites identify and collect information about users.
- First-Party Tracker: The website you're visiting tracks the user clicks and behaviour
- Third-Party Tracker: entity, other than the website directly visited by the user, that tracks the user's visit to the website.

Tracking Mechanisms:

- Cookies
- Browser Fingerprinting
- Tracking Pixel (Web Beacon)
