1. The Rules of Engagement (RoE) does not need to be approved by the client. It is simply a reference document for the red team.

The RoE requires client approval. It contains vital information such as in-scope targets, TTPs and other important information.

2. The addresses of the targets, client name, client contacts and target controls must be included in the RoE.



Client name, client contacts, project contacts, addresses, target controls and more must be documented in the Rules of Engagement.

3. The Rules of Engagement replaces the Red Team Operational Plan



The RoE is a precursor to the actual Physical Red Team Operations Plan, not a replacement for it.
