**1. The Rules of Engagement (RoE) does not need to be approved by the client. It is simply a reference document for the red team.**



The RoE requires client approval. It contains vital information such as in-scope targets, TTPs and other important information.

**2. The addresses of the targets, client name, client contacts and target controls must be included in the RoE.**



Client name, client contacts, project contacts, addresses, target controls and more must be documented in the Rules of Engagement.

**3. The Rules of Engagement replaces the Red Team Operational Plan**



The RoE is a precursor to the actual Physical Red Team Operations Plan, not a replacement for it.
