1. Recon intelligence reviews are best conducted individually.



Recon intel reviews are best conducted in a group setting. Each operator should present their intel (photos, videos, notes) to their red team counterparts for the development of a collaborative operation.

2. Vulnerability analysis is a part of the Direct Preparations phase and consists primarily of assessing whether or not an actual vulnerability exists and whether it supports adequate enough evidence to support a go-forward for testing.



Vulnerability analysis primarily involves the evaluation of whether or not there is an actual vulnerability and if it should be tested.

3. Capturing evidence, such as video, at this phase, is not required.



Evidence, such as photo and videos, are essential to the recon phase. Evidence is analyzed during this phase to identify where there are security vulnerabilities.
