Lights should only be turned on when absolutely necessary, otherwise, they should be turned off. It is preferred to use low lumen red light LEDs instead of white light LEDs.

5. If inter-team comms are lost during an operation, hand signaling is a good backup plan for communicating with one another.



Hand signals are a good fallback if the primary means of inter-team communication (ie: two-way radios) is lost.
