We're now writing and committing code like a developer. The following assumes that you have <u>.NET 6</u> installed on a machine acting as your "developer workstation". I'm using .NET 6 and PowerShell Core on Windows, but since these are both cross-platform, you can use whichever OS you like.

First, clone the empty project.



Cloning into 'mycalculator'... warning: You appear to have cloned an empty repository.

Move into the new directory and switch to the main branch.



Create a new dotnet solution.



Now we can commit that change and push it back to GitLab.
